TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE

PROBLEM

SOLUTION

After depressing the knob or lever does not return to horizontal position

Knob or lever is easily pulled off

Privacy pin is located on the wrong side

Remove the knobs or levers, trim plates, mounting plates, and latch. Rotate the latch 180° and re-install mounting plates, trim plates, and knobs or levers. reinsert the spindle into the latch ensuring the "V" grove is facing down. Re-install the mounting plates, trim plates, and knobs or levers. The spindle is not oriented properly. Remove the knobs or levers, trim plates, and mounting plates. Remove the spindle and

Handle set is not properly aligned. Remove the knob or lever, trim plates, and loosen the mounting screws. Align the mounting mounting plates and re-installed the trim plates and knob or lever.
